The Redwood Region Logging Conference is pleased to announce their 2020 Forest Education Program. We look forward to your participation with us and we hope that you will take a few moments to review the enclosed material.

Our goal is to provide a positive learning environment about our forests and their endless cycle, while insuring a quality educational experience for all participating students and teachers. To achieve this goal with our existing volunteer force and fiscal resources, the RRLC Board of Directors have establish the following programs:

- The 2020 **Mural Contest** is open to grades K through 8<sup>th</sup> in all Mendocino, Lake, Del Norte, and Humboldt Counties Schools. Please review this material, indicate your interest on the Forest Education Program Application form, and <u>mail or fax it back to us by December 13, 2019</u>. Pulp sheets will be delivered to participating classrooms by mid January. Every class returning a completed mural that does not win a cash prize will **RECEIVE A \$50 PARTICIPATION REWARD**.
- 2) Education Day will be held Thursday, March 19, 2020, the opening day of the 82nd annual Redwood Region Logging Conference at the Redwood Empire Fairgrounds in Ukiah. Attendance will be limited to 1,500 Mendocino and Lake County school children, grades 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6th. Bus transportation costs for authorized classes, will be reimbursed by the Redwood Region Logging Conference provided the following requirements are met:
  - a) The RRLC Education Day field trip is an approved school activity and is covered by the school's liability insurance;
  - b) An invoice and supporting documentation is submitted to the RRLC Office by May 15, 2020 for reimbursement not to exceed \$250.

We hope that you will consider these educational opportunities and we look forward to receiving your program application form.

## 2020 Mural Contest Rules for Grades K-8th

- 1. Mural must portray the 2020 Conference theme: "Redwood Roots, Redwood Community, Redwood People." Possible Careers: Forester, Fishery or Wildlife Biologist, Equipment Operator, Logger, Tree Faller, Mill Worker, Welder, Mechanic, Truck Driver, Tree Planter, Drone Timber Cruiser.....
- 2. Mural must be created on pulp sheets provided by the Conference. **ONE PULP SHEET PER CLASSROOM / PER TEACHER.**
- 3. Murals may be created using crayons, watercolors, poster paints, paper collage and other unique materials. Use your imagination! **Remember, murals will be hung on a wall for display.** Murals that are not appropriately designed for wall hanging will be disqualified.
- 4. Murals will be judged on the use of the conference theme, creative use of materials and whole class participation. The murals should be age appropriate with work done by the students with innovated uses of wood products and design. The murals should be a learning experience for students; demonstrating an understanding of the interrelationship between the forest and human communities; the renewal ability over time of a managed forest; and the many people working together to fulfill the importance of wood products in our everyday lives.
- 5. The teacher's name, grade, school, and telephone number must be on a 3x5 card stapled flat on the **bottom right-hand corner** of the mural facing up so the writing is visible. (Please do Not fold and staple)
- 6. Each class not receiving a cash prize will **RECEIVE A \$50 PARTICIPATION REWARD!**
- 7. **PRIZES:** The murals will be divided into two grade categories for judging: K-3<sup>rd</sup> grades and 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades. If you have a 3/4 combination, the mural will be judged in the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade category. Prizes are:

**HUMBOLDT/DELNORTE/TRINITY COUNTIES**: First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each.

**MENDOCINO/LAKE COUNTIES:** First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each. (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Reward.*)

- 8. Murals must be received for judging no later than **Friday, March 13, 2020 at 5 PM**. Please deliver your completed mural to one of the following locations:

- 9. Murals will be displayed during the Redwood Region Logging Conference, March 19, 20 & 21, 2020, at the Redwood Empire Fairgrounds in Ukiah, CA. RRLC Directors or the Office of Education will make every effort to return murals.
- 10. The RRLC reserves the right to reproduce, publish, or publicly display any mural for the benefit of the RRLC, along with the right to retain the ownership of any mural, as chosen by the RRLC Education Committee.
- 11. Any mural, which is determined by the RRLC Education Committee to be inappropriate, will be disqualified, and will not be displayed at the conference.
